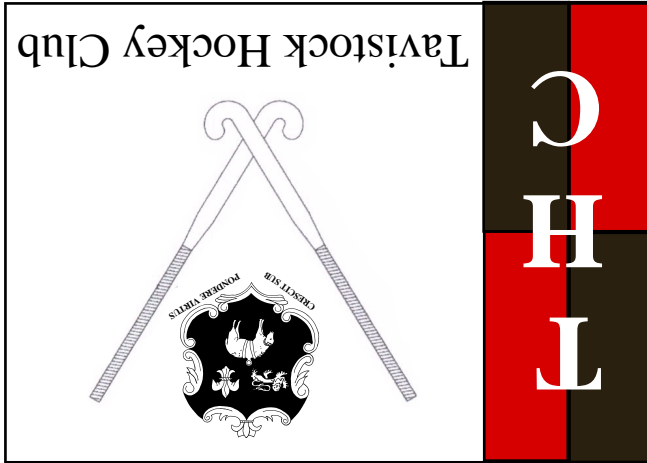


Handbook 2007/2008 Season



Club History

[Tavistock Hockey Club](#) was formed in 1948 when the pitch was purchased by Messrs, Morrison, Maunder, Treloar and White who became the first Trustees of the club.

Since 1948 the club has run both Men's and Ladies teams without a break, to the present, which is a testament to the tenacity of the club members throughout the years.

In 1965, Messrs Treloar and White resigned as Trustees and Cooper and Davey were appointed.

In 1977 the existing Trustees retired and new Trustees (the clubs present Trustees), Mr.P.Plumb, Mrs.I.Pennington, Mrs.S.Spackman and Mr.C.Owen were appointed.

The Trustees are the "Legal" Owners of the club and are responsible for overseeing the affairs of the club. The day to day running of the club falls to the Committee who are elected by the membership of the A.G.M.

Although the club pitch has always been in its present location, the pitch was not precisely in the same position in 1948 as it is today. In 1966 by agreement with the developers of the Grenville Drive Housing, a land "swap" took place to enable the construction of development. This placed the pitch in the position it is today.

The Committee are currently in the process of selling the pitch and will be using the proceeds to improve Hockey in Tavistock.

Insurance
Members are covered for any activity, including playing, training, fund raising or social event. If you cause injury or financial loss to a fellow member. The cover provides a "no fault" compensation for members who are injured whilst participating in an authorised/organised activity including direct travel to and from home. We are also covered for injury to non-members including youngsters at official coaching and mini hockey training. We are NOT covered for:
1. Dental treatment or repair
2. Replacement of spectacles
3. Physiotherapy benefit
4. Temporary total disablement from usual occupation

Code of Conduct & Practice for All members of the Club

This code falls into two parts:

1. On the field of play members should not, at any time use unacceptable language directed at fellow players or umpires will be worthy of sanction; criticise or make comment on the umpires ability or decisions; indulge in physical or violent play which could lead to injury; Resort to unfair tactics to secure an advantage; Bring the game or Club into disrepute by unsporting conduct or discourtesy; Under most circumstances arrive late to a match or at a meeting place prior to departure; Fail to turn up without prior warning to the team captain.
2. As much notice as possible should be given if you cannot meet your team commitment. After a match it is every members responsibility to take care of the equipment, eg, nets, pads etc; ensure that the Changing rooms are left in a clean and tidy state, the rubbish removed; help entertain the opposition in a sociable fashion; ensure your appearance and your kits are clean and of the Club specification. When spectating, support your Club by all means without abusive or insulting comments towards players or umpires.
3. As a Club member you have certain responsibilities. These are intended to ensure the smooth running of the Club and for the benefit of all members. It is every members responsibility to make sure that; annual subscriptions and match fees are paid; to phone in each week at times stated by respective captains; to support in whatever way possible the elected officials of the Club, especially your captains; to accept selection with good grace; to support the Club organised activities as often as possible, not only Saturdays and Sunday fixtures but also tournaments, socials, meetings and fundraising activities.
 - The Captain will have the right to send a player off.
 - Suspension from the team for a match or a number of matches. The member will be informed if this has been applied to his/her selection.
 - A member may be called to give account to the committee for disciplinary matters.

Further details of RED card disciplinary procedures, and subsequent bans, are given on the EHA Website under the Code of Discipline.

Above all, the objective should be to enjoy our hockey and enable the club to prosper.

The application of the above will vary between the winter leagues and the summer mixed leagues, where traditionally it has been more relaxed and focused on recruitment and development.

- Ø The majority of the players should be Tavistock club members. Those that are not should have played the match fees such that they are covered for insurance
 - Ø Generally the Squad of players should not exceed 14.
- The captains should use the following points as guidance in their selection criteria:
- Ø Provide an environment where people may enjoy playing hockey
 - Ø Demonstrate a good standard of play and win matches in order to attract new players
 - Ø Give players from the second teams the opportunity to play at a higher level in order to improve.
 - Ø Provide a training experience for new players
 - Ø Be flexible enough to allow potential recruits to play
 - Ø Have a squad of players to enable intermittent attendees to play when they are available; noting that whilst the preference is for a consistent and committed team this is not always practicable.
- The responsibility for achieving the balance of the above points, in order that the club might grow and develop, rests firmly with the Captains of each team. As they pursue this aim there may be occasions where a large squad is taken to a match or players from other clubs are invited to play.

It goes without saying that they key principle for team selection is to ensure that the team are able to beat the opposition. To achieve this objective there are many issues that need to be considered in order to ensure that Captains have players of the required standard available for selection. Foremost of these issues is the continued growth and development of the Club, which is made up of the individual teams. To support the club in meeting this objective, the teams need to :
